DOVER FIRST BAPTIST IS 258 YEARS OLD TOMORROW.

The Dover First Baptist Church was founded in 1757. It is the oldest church in the town of Dover Plains and the second oldest continuous active Baptist Church in the State of New York. "The Church was organized under the leadership of Rev. William Marsh who was a Baptist minister from New Jersey and helped the community of believers assembled on November 9, 1757 to establish a covenant and appoint a pastor. Formally the church was named the First Church of Christ in Beekman's Precinct. On January 4, 1758 Pastor Samuel Waldo was chosen as the first church pastor/ elder.
