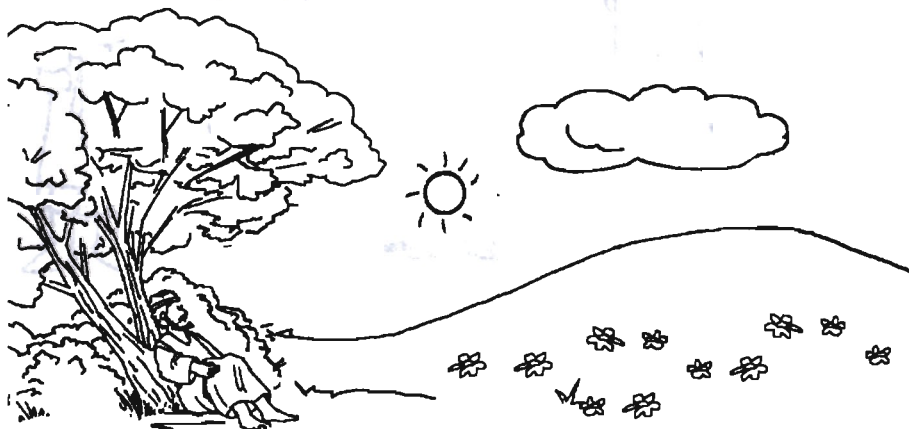

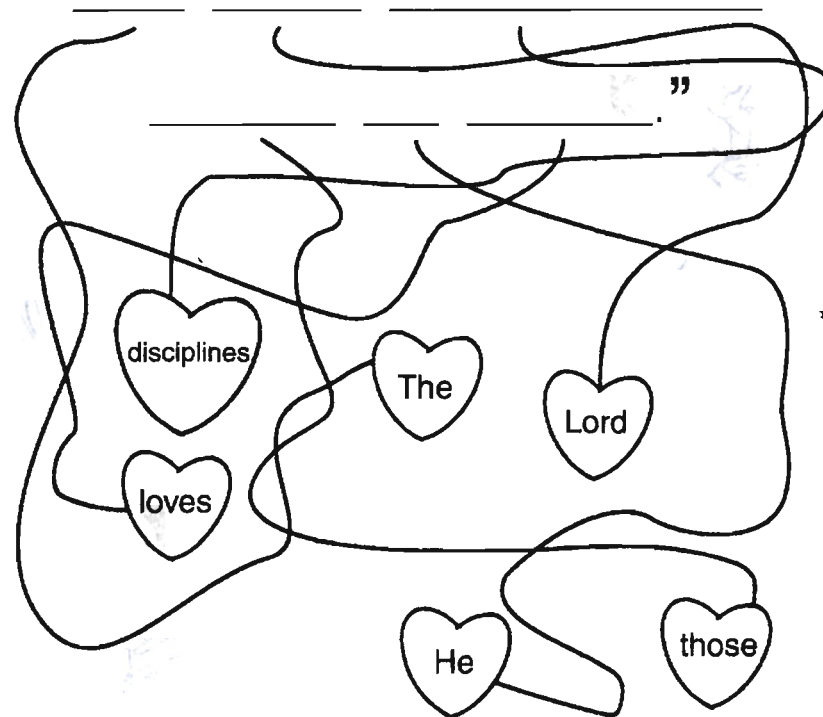
## The Discipline of the Lord

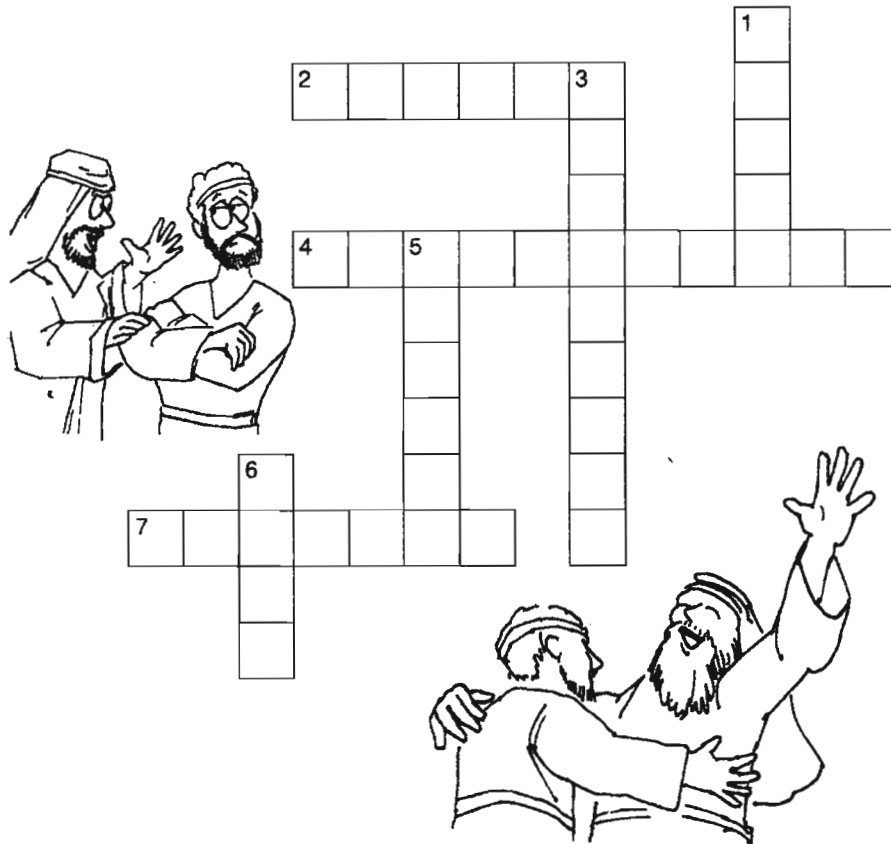

Fit these words into the crossword puzzle. Then use the numbers to place them in the correct blanks to complete the verse.

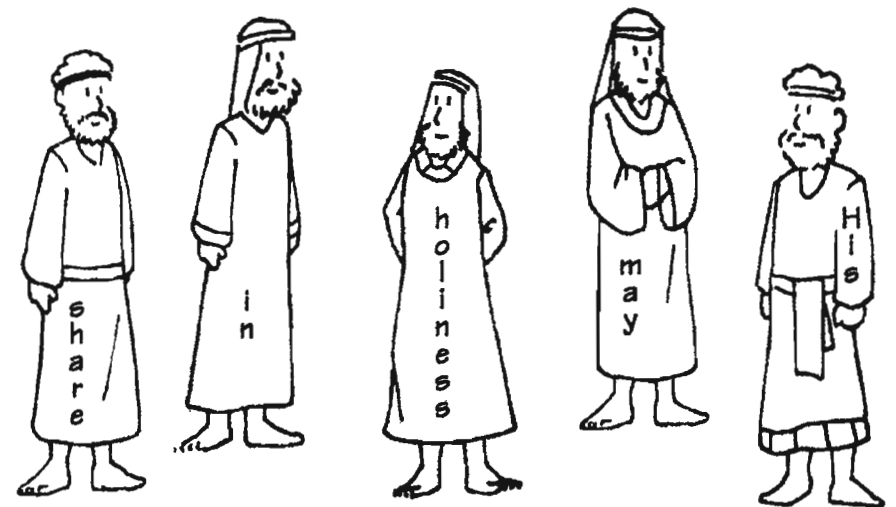
