In America, was founded by Sonora Smart Dodd, and THERS celebrated on the third Sunday of June for the first time in 1910. It is held on various days in many parts of the world

all throughout the year, often in the months of March, May and June. The first known Father's Day service occurred in Fairmont, West Virginia, on July 5, 1908, after hundreds of men died in the worst mining accident in U.S. history. It killed more than 360 men and boys, and left about 1,000 children fatherless. The Sunday service happened because of the efforts of Grace Golden Clayton, the daughter of a dedicated reverend.
