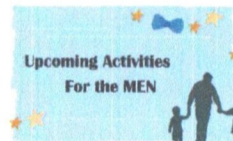

## For the Praise of His Glory

If we are ever going to understand anything about life we must begin by recognizing God's purpose for everything in life. We must recognize first that everything exists for God's glory. Paul concludes Romans 11 with one of the most glorious doxologies in all the Bible: "For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to whom be glory for ever. Amen."

Why is there something rather than nothing? Why does anything exist besides God? Everything that exists is ultimately of Him and through Him and to Him.

He is the Source of all things. John 1:3 says: "All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made."

He is the Sustainer of all things. Colossians 1:17 says, "He is before all things, and by him all things consist."

He is the Goal, the End of all things. Psalm 19:1 says, "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork."

God's purpose in all things is for His glory to be known. Why did God create human beings? Isaiah 43:6-7 says, "Bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth; Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory."

God created mankind, as Genesis 1:26 says, to reflect His image. People are more like God than anything else in His creation . . . Rejoicing in God's glory is our highest calling and most satisfying enjoyment. God created us not just to recognize His glory but to rejoice in it.
