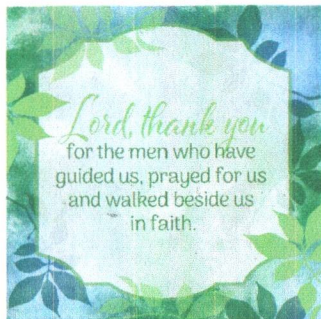

Are you a Bible-reading father seeking to impart its truths to your children? Reading the Bible is good, and obeying the Bible makes it effective. The Bible says of itself, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness" (2 Timothy 3:16).

My father, a man of God and of the Bible, read it with his family every morning right after breakfast. I was recently going through some of his things in storage when I came across one of his Bibles. Here are a few of the verses he had underlined:

- "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us" (Titus 3:5a).
- "Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee" (Hebrews 13:5).
- "Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth" (Colossians 3:2).

These verses are a picture of how my father thought and lived. Whether your father was like that or not, you can by God's grace make the Bible an important part of your own life. Then those who know you best will know you as a man of the Bible.
